RULE CHANGES as agreed by Council to take effect from 1st January 2005

Rule 205.1 Qualifications for NZ Nationals

All skaters must have competed in either a Club Competition or a Regional Sub Association Championship in the year in order to qualify for Nationals. The Council may give dispensation to skaters who do not compete in either competition.

(The change being a skater does not have to compete in both Club and Regional Sub Association Championship). This Rule applies to all divisions.

Rule 229 Short Program Time – Senior, Junior, Novice, Intermediate and Primary increased to upto 2.50

Rule 229.1a Novice Short Programme – Optional Single or Double Axel

Rule 229.2 Time allowance in Free Programmes add plus or minus 10 seconds.

Rule 231 Pair Skating – Pair Lift Groups as per ISU new Groupings

SKATERS - AMATEUR COACHING

A form is to be produced and completed by skaters who are also coaching. This form is to be submitted yearly. Any skater who does not submit this form could jeopardize their eligibility status.

NEW CLUB

We welcome another Club in to our fold. Canterbury Masters Figure Skating Club has been accepted as a member of the NZ Ice Skating Association. The Club's members are mainly Masters Skaters, Recreational Skaters and Coffee Club Ladies who wish to obtain training ice in the evenings. Some of the members are also involved in the Masters Games and they wish to encourage former skaters and others in their age group to return to the ice at a time when the Competitive Skaters are not training. The Club plans to hold an annual competition and will invite skaters of all ages to participate.
