

#### **Christmas Newsletter**



#### **Some Mathematical thoughts**

When does 2 x 3 not equal 3 x 2? In the judging of ice skating where arithmetic rules are rewritten.

Two triple jumps score more than three double jumps. For example 3 double loops gives 4.5 and 2 triple loops gives 10 points. But in the last half of the program these values can increase by 10 per cent.

And then there is the grade of execution to consider which can alter these values further.
