As this event will also be used for selection for Australian competition, there will be some skaters from other South Island clubs competing.

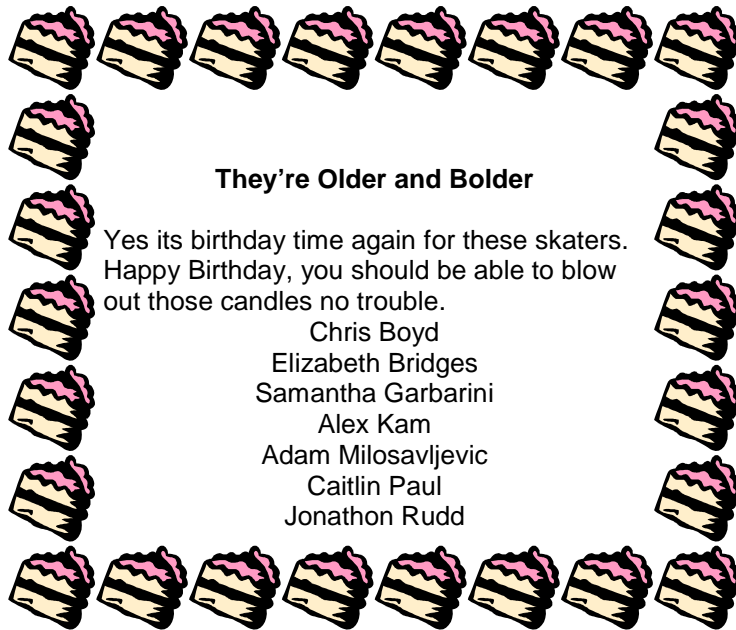

Iain Pollock has been skating for about 10 years along side with his younger sister Alanna. Iain first got into skating when he was 2 years old, because his mother wanted to attend coffee club. He had a break for a few years and restarted at the age of 6 when he was a regular attender of Kiwiskate classes. After a few more years he graduated to private lessons.

He competed in the Intermediate men's grade last year, passing the test for Novice Men at the end of 2003. Last year would have been one of Iain's most successful years, after winning the Intermediate Mens National title and then making selection to represent New Zealand at the Australian Nationals, gaining an impressive 2nd place.

Iain is a very strong skater, especially with his jumps, which are huge! He is becoming well known for his near consistent (or at least, fearlessly attempted) double axel, which he landed in most of his warm-ups last year, but just missed in his programs. He hopes to change that this year! He has been working hard on his spins and footwork to make his programmes not just technically strong, but also to bring his presentation marks up steadily.
